
We cordially invite you to participate in the Shiley Eye Center and UC San Diego Department of Ophthalmology's Educational Programs for 2012-2013.

Residents & Fellows Annual Research Day

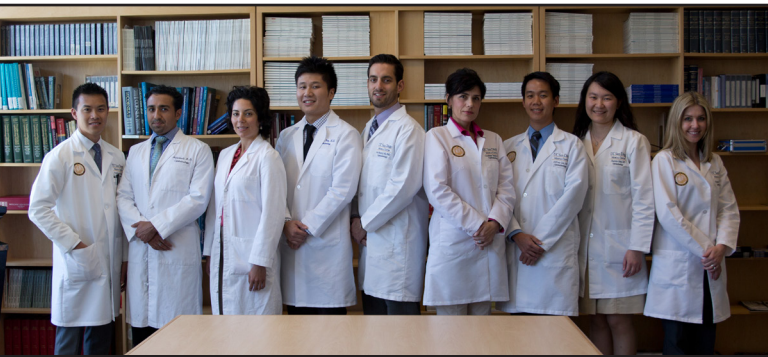

Directions to the Shiley Eye Center:

From I-5: Exit on Genesee Avenue and head East to Campus Point Drive. Turn right onto Campus Point Drive and then turn right on Medical Center Drive at the stop sign. Turn left into parking lot P751. The Shiley Eye Center is located west of the parking lot.

From I-805: Exit La Jolla Village Drive and go West. Turn right on Regents Road. Turn left on Health Sciences Drive and turn right on Medical Center Drive. Turn left into parking lot P751 the Shiley Eye Center is located west of the parking lot.

The Shiley conference room is located outside the west side of the Shiley Eye Center.
